

Blue Fulmar - Details of Ownership – April 2004 to Present

The vessel was purchased in April 2004, since then it has been moored on the east coast and used for cruising on the Norfolk Broads, the East Coast, France, Holland and Belgium.

It has been maintained professionally throughout the period of ownership by Goodchild Marine Services of Burgh Castle, Gt Yarmouth. They have carried out all the mechanical work on the engine and utility systems including annual lift-out, onshore storage from November to March each year, winterisation, re-commissioning, annual engine service etc. All bills evidencing the work carried out can be viewed on request at Goodchild Marine Services.

The vessel is for sale as I intend to retire within a few years and I intend to down size to a smaller vessel to be used primarily on the Norfolk Broads.

The following is a summary of the work carried out over the six years of my ownership:

Deck

New auto inflate danbouy 2005
New lifebelt & light 2005
Manual windlass stripped, serviced, repainted 2005
New Zodiac 4 man canister liferaft and stainless steel rack 2006
New Honda 2.3 HP outboard 2009
All mooring lines replaced with 3 strand buff polyester 2009
Teak deck regularly treated with Burgess woodsealer (2/3 times per annum)

Hull

Wax polished and buffed every year before re-launch
New anodes fitted every year before re-launch
Anti-fouled every year before re-launch
Propeller and shaft cleaned and polished every year before re-launch

Superstructure

Stripped down to bare wood and re-varnished (6 coats) between 2005 and 2007
New twin horn fitted 2008

Masts/Rigging

Mast and spars removed winter of 2004/2005, all fittings removed, stripped down to bare wood and re-varnished (8 coats), Fittings re-installed, all blocks replaced, Running rigging replaced with braided buff polyester 2009

Engine

Fuel injection pump reconditioned 2004.
Engine mounts replaced 2004
Separate tandem fuel filtration system fitted 2007 complete with new fuel lines
Fuel tanks drained and flushed 2007
New filler caps and piping fitted 2008/9
New fuel tank vents fitted 2008/9
Service and engine start batteries replaced 2008
Fore & aft electric bilge pumps replaced 2009
New weed box and seacock fitted to engine cooling water intake 2010

Interior

Shower and shower pump fitted 2004
Fridge replaced 2008
All interior light fittings replaced with high quality brass 2009
Brass lamps fitted 2009
Other interior fittings replaced with high quality brass 2009
Fore and aft cabin sides lined with sapele hard wood 2009

Spare Parts

Numerous engine and mechanical spares are included, all of which are new i.e.:

4 x new injectors, starter motor, service battery, bilge pump, fuel lift pump, shower pump, pressurised water system pump, fuel filters, oil filters, engine gasket sets, bulbs, fuses. Etc.

Testing/Certification

The liferaft, flares and all fire extinguishers have always been tested and certified in accordance with manufacturers recommendations and are currently all in date.
